

# Coronavirus rules in Scotland: What's new from the 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020?

The Scottish Government has announced changes to the rules for people living in Scotland.



No more than 6 people from 2 households can meet together. This is indoors and outdoors.

This doesn't affect children under 12.



If you are visiting a cafe, pub or restaurant you will need to wear a mask when you are moving around.

For example: coming in the door, leaving or going to the toilet.



You can take your mask off while you are eating or drinking.



Weddings and funerals can have up to 20 people there as long as they are held at places which are for that purpose.

Safety measures must also be in place.



## Local Lockdowns

**Local Lockdown rules are currently in place in Glasgow, North and South Lanarkshire, East and West Dunbartonshire, Renfrewshire and East Renfrewshire.**



In these places people are being advised not visit other households indoors.
