The Scottish Government promise to 'significantly reduce' long hospital stays and out-of-area residential placements for people with learning disabilities or complex needs by March 2024 has not been met.



We are disappointed by the lack of progress. A single day living in these places is too long. We need action, not words.



Inclusion in the definition of Mental Disorder means people with a learning disability can still be detained.



Action : Remove learning disability from the definition of mental disorder in the Mental Health Act.



People in hospital are not being fully supported to have choice and control over where they move on to in the community.

Action: Establish a system of Supported Decision-Making in Scotland so we can be supported to think about and make our own decisions.



People are being forced to live in group homes with restrictions placed on them that are similar to hospital.

Action : Realise our right to independent living by giving us true choice and control over our own life.



People with a learning disability continue to be detained in hospital.

Action : Close these hospitals!
